

Secondary School Customized Enrollment Option (CEO)

- Designed for parents who desire:
 - home school education for their children
 - alternate providers for certain classes
 - a more cost-effective way to provide Christian education

General Requirements for Secondary (6-12) CEO Students/Parents

- Parents of CEO students are required to fully satisfy the home school laws of Florida and provide proof to CCS of their intention to home school. Parents are primarily responsible for their child's education and CCS is not responsible for their education.
- **Families desiring to enroll a student full time receive priority over CEO students in the event classes should cap.**
- Students must enroll in a minimum of one class and can take up to a maximum of four classes.
- Tuition for classes is prorated based upon the tuition rates for the school year enrolled; contact the business office (893-6628) for more information.
- Additional fees (application, lab, registration, book, athletic, arts, leadership program, field trip or late) apply to CEO students.
- Financial aid and/or discounts are not available for the CEO program.
- CEO students are required to adhere to school policies as outlined in the CCS Parent-Student Handbook.
- CEO students are subject to the same admissions requirements and procedures as those students who are enrolled full time.
- CEO applicants who have been homeschooled for a majority of their education must provide the admissions committee with a comprehensive portfolio of current student work in English and math or provide current standardized testing results.
- CEO students may participate in certain extracurricular and co-curricular programs available to full time CCS students.
- CEO students in the secondary school may participate in class field trips for classes in which they are enrolled.
- CEO student class schedules vary based upon the availability of desired classes.
- CEO students must be punctual for class and must be picked up at the conclusion of their classes.
- CEO students will receive a report card at the end of each nine-week grading period for all classes in which they are enrolled.
- CEO students may participate in spring achievement testing.
- CEO students may not participate in the middle school promotion ceremony or the high school commencement ceremony.

Additional High School Requirements

- CEO students in the high school program who qualify are eligible for participation in the Leadership Program. Students must take a Biblical Studies course as a part of their schedule and participate in required leadership program activities.
